INFORMATION SHEET – RULES FOR ENTRY
WGG 13th JURIED EXHIBITION March 11-April 4, 2008

REQUIREMENTS

1. Entrant must be a current paid-up WGG member for 2007 and 2008.
2. Entry pieces must have been completed within the last 2 years and not previously exhibited in a juried show.
3. Entrant must submit a minimum of 2 pieces for the METALWORK 2008 SHOW, and may submit a maximum of 4 pieces.
4. Entrant may submit an additional 3 pieces for the WGG \$200.80 Challenge (pieces priced up to \$200.80). *Only entrants to the METALWORK 2008 may enter the WGG \$200.80 Challenge.*
5. All work must be priced and available for sale.
6. Pieces must be hand delivered for jury review in October and for the show in March.
7. Work submitted for the show will be photographed and those images become WGG property and will be used at the discretion of the WGG.
8. Participants are expected to “sit the show” at least one morning or afternoon during the run of the show. Out of town participants unable to “sit the show” may contribute \$20. to the education fund instead.

- B. METALWORK 2008 Entry Form Part 1, & fee payment must be received by JANET LONG (address above) **BY OCTOBER 1, 2007**. Leave “Entrant #” blank as it will be assigned at drop off.

FEES: METALWORK 2008- \$20 per piece, or \$55 for up-to 4 pieces
WGG \$200.80 Challenge- \$10 for up to 3 Pieces

Deliver pieces for jury review on Saturday, **October 13, 2007** between 2pm and 7pm to the studio at Creative Metalworks, 10501 Wheatley Street, Kensington, MD 20895.

>>The appropriate ID Tag should be typed to each corresponding piece. **Wrap and box each entry separately**, then put them together in a larger box. *Please keep METALWORK 2008 pieces separate from WGG \$200.80 Challenge pieces.*

- C. Pick up your entries at Creative Metalworks on Saturday, **October 20** between 1:30pm and 5pm. All items must be dropped off and picked up on these dates. You are responsible for making alternative arrangements if you cannot deliver or pick up items.

- D. Deliver accepted pieces to the Creative Partners Gallery, located at 4600 East-West Highway in Bethesda, MD Saturday, **March 8, 2008** between 2pm and 7pm.
Exhibit pieces may be picked up on **April 5, 2008**.
