

2020 WGG MERIT SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND SUBMISSION

REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility

This award is open to all registered metalsmithing students who have taken Jewelry or Metalsmithing courses, or Crafts courses with an emphasis on metals processes, during the current or previous academic year (Fall 2019- Spring 2020)

Awards

WGG Emerging Artist Award

- \$300 Allcraft USA Gift Certificate + 2 Year WGG membership, and the opportunity to apply to Metalwork 2022 Biennial Exhibition.

Jurors' Choice Awards (2 winners chosen)

- \$200 Allcraft USA Gift Certificate + 2 Year WGG membership, and the opportunity to apply to Metalwork 2022 Biennial Exhibition.

Calendar

- **May 15th, 2020** Completed application (images + statement)
- **June 1st, 2020** Award winners will be notified
- **Fall 2020** Formal Award Ceremony to be held at the opening reception of 'METALWORK 2020 biennial show. Selected candidates will be invited to attend to receive their awards & to be recognized for their work.

Submission requirements - *submission implies WGG right to make use of all images for publicity purposes.

1/ Images

Images of 2 or 3 completed projects (can submit up to one additional detail per object, if desired)

- Images should be between 1400 pixels x 2000 pixels longest dimension at 300ppi
- Files should be titled: FirstnameLastnameA; FirstnameLastnameB, etc.
- If detail image is submitted, use the following convention – FirstNameLastNameAdetail; FirstNameLastNameBdetail, etc.

2/ Artist Statement.

Students should present a short written statement based on the following.

- Course or courses in which you were enrolled, and Instructor (Between Fall 2018 – Spring 2020)
- Explain the ideas behind the work you submitted.
- What I envisage using the Award for to further my interest in the metal arts.
- What I found the most surprising part about studying metal arts.
